acute care

Amount (and intensity) of therapy

An average of 1 to 2 hours per day.

A minimum of 3 hours per day, 5 days a week.

Physician involvement

An attending physician provides an initial assessment within 30 days of admission.

Physician care is provided 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Nursing care

A registered nurse is in the building for 8 hours per day. The nurse-to-patient ratio is one nurse aide to 20 to 30 patients.

Nursing care is provided 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, by registered nurses as well as Certified Rehabilitation Registered Nurses (CRRN). The nurse-to-patient ratio is one nurse to 6 or 7 patients.

Treatment team

A multidisciplinary personal rehab team.

Length of stay

The national average length of time spent at a skilled nursing facility is 28 days.

A The national average length of time spent at an acute inpatient rehab hospital is 16 days.
